- Long-time community goal

 - Access to Charbonneau when I-5 congested
 - Incident response for emergency responders
 - Redundant connection to I-5 Boone Bridge:
 Improves I-5 resiliency



- Community-driven vision to 're-make' our town center

- 100-acre project area includes:
 - Clackamas Community College Wilsonville Campus, Town Center shopping center, Fry's Electronics, Regal Cinemas Theater
- Attractive, commercially vibrant, mixed-use district
 - -Easily accessible and pedestrian friendly

- +200-acre Regionally Significant Industrial Area
 - New developments proposed
- 1,800 jobs, \$55 million annual payroll
- Urban Renewal Area
 - -New businesses help pay to develop
 - Attract companies of high-quality employment
 - -Pay taxes that support public services




- Frog Pond West Master Plan
