ORDINANCE NO. 19

AN ORDINANCE CREATING A PARK COMMISSION FOR THE CITY OF WILSONVILLE; DEFINING ITS DUTIES; AND REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 17.

THE CITY OF WILSONVILLE ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: CREATING COMMISSION AND APPOINTMENT OF MEMBERS.

A Park Commission for the City of Wilsonville is hereby created which shall consist of seven members, one of whom shall be a member of the City Council and all of whom shall be residents of the City. Commission members shall be appointed by the Mayor with approval of the Council, and shall be known as "Park Commissioners".

Section 2: TERMS OF OFFICE.

The Councilman Commission member shall serve during his elected term as Councilman; three of the others of the initial Commission shall serve for one year and the others for two years, and all terms thereafter shall be for two years. The initial Commission shall be appointed at the first Council meeting after this Ordinance takes effect. Commission members shall continue in office until their successors are appointed; they can be reappointed; and may be removed by the Council at any time.

Section 3: ORGANIZATION AND COMPENSATION.

At its first meeting in each calendar year, the Commission shall elect a Chairman and a Secretary. The Chairman shall preside at all meetings and the Secretary shall keep the Minutes and a record of all activities and report at least quarterly to the City Council. Roberts Rules of Order shall govern the meetings, and all members are entitled to vote. Commission members shall serve without pay but may be reimbursed for any expenses incurred in the discharge of their duties.

Section 4: POWERS AND DUTIES.

The Park Commission shall be advisory to the City Council on matters pertaining to the acquisition, operation and maintenance of City Parks and recreational facilities, and for that purpose shall:

- a. Study ways and means for improvement and beautification of City Parks;
- b. Assist in developing annual Park budgets and recommend programs for developing income for Park purposes;
- c. Advise on needs and locations for additional Parks, playgrounds or other recreational facilities;
- d. Recommend Park rules or changes in rules and recommend policies for Park management;
- e. Evaluate the public's need for Parks and recreational facilities and keep the Council informed on such matters; and
- f. Advise on selection of a Park's Director and City Forester and assist in defining their duties and responsibilities.

Section 5: MEETINGS.

The Park Commission shall hold meetings at least monthly at a time and place agreed upon, and all meetings shall be open to the public, and shall be publicly announced at the preceding City Council meeting.

Section 6: Ordinance No. 17 entitled "AN ORDINANCE CREATING A PARK COMMISSION FOR THE CITY OF WILSONVILLE AND DEFINING ITS DUTIES" enacted by the Wilsonville City Council on second and final reading at a regular meeting of the Council on January 25, 1971, is hereby repealed.

Passed on first reading at a regular meeting of the Wilsonville City Council held on the 22nd day of March, 1971; ordered posted in three (3) public and conspicuous places in the City of Wilsonville for a period of five (5) consecutive days as required by the Wilsonville City Charter, and to come up for final reading and action of the Wilsonville City Council at a regular meeting thereof to be held on the 12th day of April, 1971, at the hour of 7:30 o'clock p.m. at the Council's regular meeting place in the Wilsonville IOOF Hall.
