ORDINANCE NO. 119

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR A SPECIAL ELECTION TO BE HELD IN THE CITY OF WILSONVILLE, CLACKAMAS AND WASHINGTON COUNTIES, OREGON ON THE 4th DAY OF JUNE, 1979, FOR THE PURPOSE OF SUBMITTING TO THE QUALIFIED LEGAL VOTERS OF SAID CITY THE QUESTION OF A GENERAL OBLIGATION BOND ISSUE FOR CONSTRUCTION OF ADDITIONS AND IMPROVEMENTS TO THE CITY'S SEWAGE DISPOSAL SYSTEM.

THE CITY OF WILSONVILLE ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: A special city election is hereby called to be held on Monday, June 4, 1979 for the purpose of submitting to the qualified legal voters of the City of Wilsonville pursuant to its Charter, the City's initiative and referendum Ordinance No. 6 and ORS 454.205 to 454.255 the question of contracting a general obligation bonded indebtedness in the name of the City in the sum of TWO MILLION TWO HUNDRED AND FIFTY THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$2,250,000) for a term not exceeding fifteen (15) years for the purpose of providing funds with which to construct, equip and furnish modifications and/or additions and improvements to the city's sewage disposal system and sewerage facilities to increase capacity; acquire necessary land and rights of way; pay the necessary costs of engineering and legal services; and to pay the costs of issuing the bonds.

Section 2: The Clackamas County Elections Department is requested to conduct said election on June 4, 1979 between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m. Oregon Daylight Savings Time in accordance with the general election laws of this State and in each of the regular polling places in the City, i.e. the Wilsonville Grade School for precincts 201 and 202 and the Charbonneau Recreation Hall for precinct 203; and upon conclusion of said election certify the results thereof to the Wilsonville City Council.

Section 3: The following is the ballot title and form in which the proposed bond issue shall be printed and submitted on the official ballot, except that the ballot number may be changed in order to conform to the County Elections Department numbering method for a punch-card ballot.

Section 4: The City Recorder is hereby directed to prepare a notice of said election and to have such notice published in the Tigard Times, a newspaper published in Tigard, Oregon and of general circulation in the City of Wilsonville, the first publication of such notice to be not more than 25 nor less than 15 days and the last publication not more than 14 nor less than 8 days preceeding the date of the election, and that, at least two weeks prior to said election the City Recorder shall post notices thereof at each polling place and in at least three other public, conspicuous and widely separated places in the City. The election notice to be posted and published shall be in substantially the following form:
