ORDINANCE NO. 126 AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING CONTRACT FOR CONSTRUCTION OF WILSONVILLE ROAD AND BOONES FERRY ROAD INTERSECTION; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY WHEREAS, the State Highway Department has advertised for and received bids from several contractors to install traffic signals at the intersection of Boones Ferry Road and Wilsonville Road in the City of Wilsonville; and WHEREAS, Payless Distribution Center will open its facilities in the City in August, 1979, thus impacting the intersection of Boones Ferry Road and Wilsonville Road with heavy truck movements and employees' automobile traffic; and WHEREAS, the City has the responsibility of installing a required traffic island complete with curbing, sidewalks and new lane pavement; and

WHEREAS, the shortage of time and the urgency of the completion of the project has justified a departure from the City's normal procedures of advertising for competitive bids, and has directed Westech Engineering, Inc. (the City's engineer for the project) to solicit bids for the project according to the plans and specifications prepared for the City by said Engineering Firm; and

WHEREAS, the Engineers contacted qualified contractors to submit firm estimates for the work project, the Engineers' estimated cost of which was \$7,227, not including engineering and design; and

WHEREAS, the City's Engineer solicited competitive bids and received only one, i.e., from Gradeline Construction, Inc. of Salem, Oregon, which was for a total bid and cost of \$8,780 for labor and materials; and

WHEREAS, the Wilsonville City Council has reviewed the project, its engineer's estimate of cost, the qualifications of the sole bidder, and its proposal and determined that a contract should be

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authorized with said company for the immediate construction of the work project; now therefore,

THE CITY OF WILSONVILLE ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: For the reasons recited in the preamble of this ordinance, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and the Mayor and City Recorder are authorized and directed to make, execute and deliver in the name of the City of Wilsonville and on its behalf, a contract with Gradeline Construction, Inc. for the construction of the improvements for the Engineer's project designated "Wilsonville Road, Boones Ferry Road Intersection, J0419 R-1" and according to the plans and specifications for said project as prepared by Westech Engineering, Inc., and any changes or modifications of those plans and specifications as may be approved by the City Council, and which plans and specifications are now on file in the office of the City Recorder; and

Section 2: The engineering contract between the City and Westech Engineering, Inc., previously authorized by motion of the Council, is hereby ratified and confirmed for total cost of all engineering and design services in the sum of \$1,900.

Section 3: Charges to the City by its engineer for engineering services shall be paid upon receipt of billing and approval of the Council from the Park and Road Fund; and the amount of the construction contract is to be paid upon receipt of billings and approval of the City's engineer and City Council from the Park and Road Fund.

<u>Section 4:</u> Because of the emergency herein declared to exist and the urgent need for the improvements of the Wilsonville Road and Boones Ferry Road Intersection, this Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its enactment after final reading.

Submitted to the Council and read the first time at a regular meeting of the Council on the 7th day of May, 1979, and scheduled

for second reading at a regular meeting of the Council on the 21st day of May, 1979, commencing at the hour of 7:30 o'clock P.M. at the Wilsonville Grade School.
