## ORDINANCE NO. 149

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT WITH HUMPHREY CONSTRUCTION, INC. FOR PHASE III OF SEWAGE TREATMENT PLANT EXPANSION; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Wilsonville has heretofore advertised for and received bids which were opened at the City Hall on March 11, 1980, for construction of Phase III of the City's Sewage Treatment Plant Expansion; and

WHEREAS, the plans and specifications for said project were prepared by the City's engineers, CH2M Hill of Portland, Oregon, and calls for bids were duly and regularly published in the manner and for the time required by law; and

WHEREAS, bids were publicly opened and read aloud at the Wilsonville City Hall on March 11, 1980, and the results of the bidding was reported to the Mayor and Wilsonville City Council by letter of Stewart L. Davis, Project Manager, of the City's engineers dated March 14, 1980, and said letter report and bids were considered by the Wilsonville City Council at its regular meeting on Monday, March 17, 1980, and again at the regular council meeting on Monday, April 7, 1980. There were a total of four (4) bids received as follows:

WHEREAS, the Wilsonville City Council as the City's Contract Review Board considered the bids, the plans and specifications for said project, the contract documents generally, and the reports and recommendations of its engineers and City staff, and determined that the low bid is that of Humphrey Construction, Inc. for the bid amount

of \$2,207,500 which includes adjustment for higher priced owner-selected equipment as discussed in the letter report to the Mayor and Council by Project Manager Stewart L. Davis, of the City's engineers, dated March 14, 1980; now therefore,

THE CITY OF WILSONVILLE ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: The bid of Humphrey Construction, Inc. of Seattle, Washington, for construction of the Phase III Sewage Treatment Plant Expansion Project, in the total amount of \$2,207,500, including ownerselected equipment as recommended by the City's engineering firm in its letter to the Mayor and City Council dated March 14, 1980, is hereby accepted for the amount of the contract for the construction of said project according to the plans and specifications as prepared by CH2M Hill.

Section 2: The Mayor and City Recorder are authorized and directed to make, execute and deliver in the name of the City of Wilsonville and on its behalf a contract with Humphrey Construction, Inc. for construction of Phase III of the City's Sewage Treatment Plant Expansion Project according to the plans and specifications therefor, and any changes or modifications of those plans and specifications as may be approved by the City Council and which said plans and specifications are now on file in the office of the City Recorder.

Section 3: Payment of the construction contract authorized by the foregoing Section 2 is to be made according to the schedule for payments as outlined in the contract documents from the proceeds of the City's sale of its General Obligation Sewer Bond Issue which was sold January 21, 1980, and dated February 1, 1980, and payments as required are to be recommended by the City's engineers and then authorized by the City Council and paid by a sewer bond warrant on the Clackamas County Treasurer.

<u>Section 4:</u> In order that the construction work for the improvement project may be commenced as soon as possible an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its enactment after final reading.

Section 5: Ordinance No. 138 entitled "AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING CONSTRUCTION OF PHASE III SEWAGE TREATMENT PLANT EXPANSION; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY" which was submitted to the Council October 15, 1979, and all other ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Submitted to the Council and read the first time at a regular meeting thereof on Monday, April 7, 1980, and scheduled for second reading at a regular meeting of the Council on the 21st day of April, 1980, commencing at the hour of 7:30 o'clock P.M., at the Wilsonville City Hall.
