

ORDINANCE NO. 155

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING CONTRACT FOR CONSTRUCTION OF WILSONVILLE ROAD SIGHT IMPROVEMENT PROJECT.

WHEREAS, the City of Wilsonville has heretofore advertised for and received bids for the construction of public improvements which are generally known and commonly referred to as Wilsonville Road Sight Improvements; and

WHEREAS, the plans and specifications for said project were prepared by the City Engineer, Westech Engineering of Salem, Oregon, and calls for bids were duly and regularly published in the Tigard Times, Tigard, Oregon; The Oregon Statesman, Salem, Oregon; and the Daily Journal of Commerce, Portland, Oregon, and two successive issues of these papers on June 24 and June 25, 1980, and,

WHEREAS, bids were publicly opened and read aloud at the Wilsonville City Hall at 2:00 o'clock p.m. on July 8, 1980, and the results of the bidding were reported to the Wilsonville City Council on July 25, 1980. There was a total of four (4) bids received as follows:

WHEREAS, the Wilsonville City Council as the City's Contract Review Board considered the bids, the plans and specifications for the said project, the reports and recommendations of its engineers and City staff, and determined that the lowest bid and best bid is that of Salem Road and Driveway Company. The motion being made, seconded and unanimously adopted, the City council approved acceptance of the low bid, the award of the contract, and authorized this ordinance as required by the City Charter, now therefore,

THE CITY OF WILSONVILLE ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: The bid of Salem Road and Driveway and the total amount of \$66,768.63 is hereby approved as the amount of the contract for construction of the Wilsonville Road Sight Improvement Project according to the plans and specifications of the said project as prepared by Westech Engineering, Inc.

Section 2: Republic Development Company shall pay to the City of Wilsonville a sum of \$23,246.84 for improvements required by Clackamas County at the east intersection of the City Center Loop Road and Wilsonville Road.

Section 3: The contract between the City and Westech Engineering, Inc., previously authorized by motion of the Council, is hereby ratified and confirmed that the total costs of all engineering and design services are \$6,683.84.

Section 4: Charges to the City by its Engineers for engineering services can be paid upon receipt of billing on approval of the Council from the Systems Development Fund; and the amount of the construction contracts is to be paid upon receipt of billings and approval of City Engineers and City Council from the Systems Development Fund.

Section 5: The Mayor and City Recorder are authorized and directed to make, execute and deliver in the name of the City of Wilsonville and on its behalf, a contract with Salem Road and Driveway for its construction of the improvement project, according to the plans and specifications. Therefore, any changes or modifications of those plans and specifications may be approved by the City Council, and said plan and specifications are now on file in the office of the City Recorder.

Section 6: In as much as the low bid of Salem Road and Driveway Company was firm for a limited time, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance will take effect immediately upon its enactment after final reading.


Submitted to the Council and read the first time at a regular meeting thereof on Monday, August 4, 1980, and scheduled for seconding reading at a special meeting of the Council on the 14th day of August, 1980, commencing at the hour of 7:30 o'clock a.m. at the Wilsonville City Hall.
