ORDINANCE NO. 163

AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING FRANCHISE FOR INSTALLATION FOR COMMUNITY ANTENNA TELEVISION SYSTEM DECLARING EMERGENCY AND OTHER MATTERS RELATED THERETO,

THE CITY OF WILSONVILLE DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Community Antenna Television System, hereinafter referred to as "CATV System" or "System", means a system of coaxial cables or other electrical conductors and equipment used, or to be used, primarily to receive television or radio signals directly or indirectly, off-theair and transmit them to subscribers for a fee.

Section 2. No person, firm or corporation shall hereafter install, construct, attach or in any other manner, place a CATV System, or any component thereof, on, within or under the public rights-of-way within the City without first obtaining a franchise authorizing such activity from the City Council. No franchise or franchises shall be granted without the Council first receiving a proposal for a CATV System from the applicant.

Section 3. Nothing contained in this Ordinance shall be construed to obligate the Council to issue a license or licenses for a CATV System.

<u>Section 4</u>. Council finds that there are owners of Community Antenna Television Systems installing such systems

or components thereof in areas near the City, and it is necessary in order to protect the best interests of the public that the installation and use of such Systems within the City be regulated according to the appropriate and acceptable standards and levels of service.

Section 5. At the time a franchise is granted, the City Council shall, after a hearing, establish a franchise fee and may place such conditions upon the exercise of the franchise rights as it finds to be within the public interests.

THEREFORE, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and the provisions of this Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its adoption by the Council, this Ordinance having been submitted to the Council and read for the first time in the regular meeting of the Council on the 20th day of October, 1980, and scheduled for second reading at its regular meeting on the 3rd day of November, 1980, commencing at the hour of 7:30 o'clock P.M., at the Council's regular meeting place at the Wilsonville City Hall.
