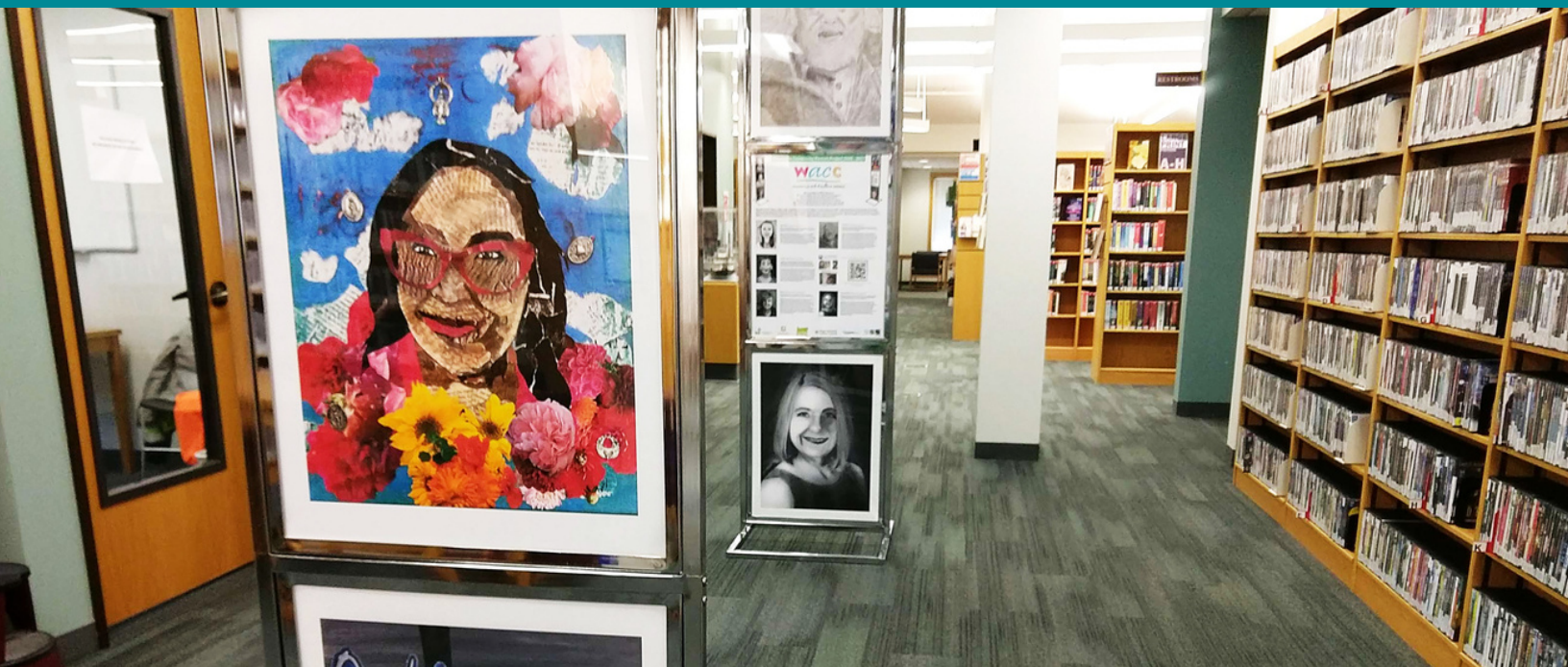

Check out these popular titles for kids and teens

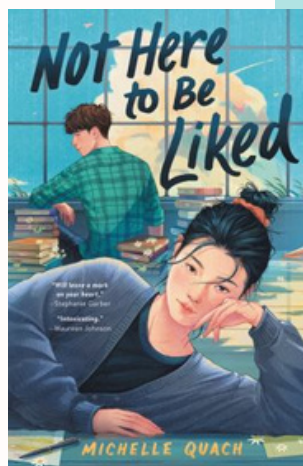
We All Play
