## ORDINANCE NO. 167

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING CONTRACTS FOR PURCHASE OF STREET LIGHTING SERVICE UNDER OPTION "B", STREET LIGHTING TARIFF AND REQUIRING ENERGY EFFICIENT LIGHTING AND AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 41.

THE CITY OF WILSONVILLE ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1</u>: It is the purpose of this Ordinance that the City of Wilsonville provide a consistent and orderly process for the development of new street lighting improvements based upon current standards and developments for construction and maintenance and for an equitable method of distribution of costs for the benefit of the public.

<u>Section 2</u>: For the purposes of this Ordinance, the following definitions apply:

- (a) Option "A" refers to that option contained in Portland General Electric Company, an Oregon Corporation, (PGE) Street Lighting Tariff, wherein luminaries are owned, maintained and supplied with electrical energy by PGE.
- (b) Option "B" refers to that option contained in PGE's Street Lighting Tarifff, wherein luminaries are owned and installed by the city/developer and supplied with energy and maintenance by PGE.

Section 3: Commencing upon adoption of this Ordinance, the City of Wilsonville shall allow only Sodium Vapor or equivalent energy efficient luminaries to be installed as new street lighting improvements.

Section 4: Commencing upon the adoption of the Ordinance, the City of Wilsonville shall require that all new street lighting improvements shall be installed under PGE Street Lighting Tariff Option "B" or a

similar ownership arrangement.

<u>Section 5</u>: This Ordinance supersedes Ordinance No. 41 only to the extent Ordinance 41 may permit contracting with PGE for new lighting service under Option "A". Nothing in the provisions of this Ordinance is intended to alter the provisions of Ordinance 41 for applicant and user payment for installation, maintenance, service and administrative costs.

Section 6: Due to the pending development projects wherein new lighting services are needed or will be needed in the immediate future, and in the interest of the general welfare, safety and health of the public, an emergency is declared to exist.

Submitted to the Council and read the first time at a regular meeting thereof on the 17th day of November, 1980, and scheduled for second reading at a regular meeting of the Council on the 1st day of December, 1980, commencing at the hour of 7:30 o'clock P.M. at the Wilsonville City Hall.
